
Next Generation

Fishers Youth Assistance Program

Fishers Youth Assistance Program (FYAP) provides professional, family-centered casework and referral services to students (ages 3 to 17) and families who reside within the Hamilton Southeastern School District. Kids and families are often referred to our services by the schools, police, court officials, and parents who have concerns about their children. The Summer Meals Program serves between 600 to 700 students who need a source of food during the summer months. Tutoring is facilitated in association with the National Honor Society programs at both Fishers and Hamilton Southeastern High Schools, volunteer teachers within the schools, and sometimes through scholarships when working with tutoring companies serving the Fishers community. Counseling & Other Mental Health Resources are provided for students through local partnerships with counselors, licensed mental health practitioners, physicians, and other community-based resources.
